WHEREAS, Hundreds of men showed exceptional heroism and devotion to their shipmanes during libs tragic accident; the Secretary of the Navy awarded medals to 178 members of the crew on April 22, 1955, and

WHEREAS, Residents of this great State must never torget the courage with which these men and women served their country, and must recognize that no greater debt is owed than that owed to those who gave their lines for their beloved Nation; and

WHEREAS, The dedication and sacrifices of our military personnel ensure our our continued role as a Nátion which embodies the ideals of democracy, and is a defender of liberty for peoples throughout the world; and

WHEREAS, This Legislative Body is very pleased to have this opportunity to express its gridulate to the men of the USS Bennington for their tremendous sacrifices made for our Nation and for the benefit of all Americans, now, therefore, be it.

RESOLVED, That this Legislative Body pause in its deliberations to commemorate the 54th Anniversary of the USS Bennington Disaster and to pay the highest tribute to the vallant service displayed by all those aboard the carrier during its time of crisis; and be if further RESOLVED. That cooles of this Resolution, suitably encrossed, be transmitted to the

families of those involved in the USS Beninington Disaster, to Joe Strohmeier, survivor and coordinator; and The Honorable Donald C. Winter, Secretary of the Navy.
